



Strategic Planning Services Questions and Answers

1. How long will the strategic plan cover (i.e. 1 year, 3 years, 5 years, etc)? 3 years.
2. How long is the intended planning process? 6 months Process to begin August 10, to be completed January 11
3. Who will be engaged in the strategic planning process? Board? Staff? Community Stakeholders? How many will be involved? Board of Directors and Key Coalition Personnel? Executive Committee (5 members) of the Board, The Coalition's Strategic Planning Team consisting of key staff and Directors, the full Board (25 members), planning and to conduct a couple of town hall meetings inviting public to participate and comment.
4. What is the level of familiarity with the Results-Based Accountability framework and/or commitment to its use? A number of our Board members as well as our CEO are members of the Children's Trust Board and participated in the Trust's Strategic Planning sessions and the Results-Based Accountability trainings. The Coalition has staff as well that attended the Results-Based Accountability trainings.
5. What resources are available for the planning group to use during the strategic planning process? The Coalition staff, office space, all of the strategic planning documents that have been produced by the Coalition's Team. The Coalition has also purchased a copy of Trying Hard Is Not Good Enough for each Board member.
