At-Risk Child Unexcused Absence Report Form

- The **Rilya Wilson Act** provides priority for child care services for specified children who are at risk of abuse, neglect, or abandonment. These children are receiving protective services and are identified on the Child Care Certificate as Funding BG1.
- **What do I do when an at-risk child is absent?**
 - When an at-risk (BG1) child has an unexcused absence or seven consecutive days of excused absences, the school readiness provider **must** notify the Family Safety Program Office of the Department of Children and Family Services or its designee (Citrus Family Care Network).
 - Starting June 1, 2022, the **At-Risk Child Unexcused Absence Report** will only be received via email to Citrus Family Care Network at BG1DaycareAbsences@citrusfcn.com
 - Keep a copy of the report for your records
- School Readiness contracted early care and education partners are obligated to immediately report:
 - **Any unexcused absence of a BG1 child by the end of the business day following the unexpected absence, or**
 - **Seven (7) consecutive excused absences of a BG1 child by the end of the seventh consecutive excused absence.**

AT RISK CHILD UNEXCUSED AT RISK CHILD ABSENCE REPORT

The Rilya Wilson Act, F.S. 39.604

Children who are in the care of the state due to abuse, neglect or abandonment must participate in a licensed early education or child care program 5 days a week. If a child covered by this law is absent from the program on a day when he or she is supposed to be present, the person with whom the child resides must report the absence to the program by the end of the business day. Children who are subject to this law may not withdraw from the program without the prior written approval of the responsible agency. All absences shall be reported the following business day to the Family Safety Program Office of the Department of Children and Family Services or its designee (Citrus Family Care Network).

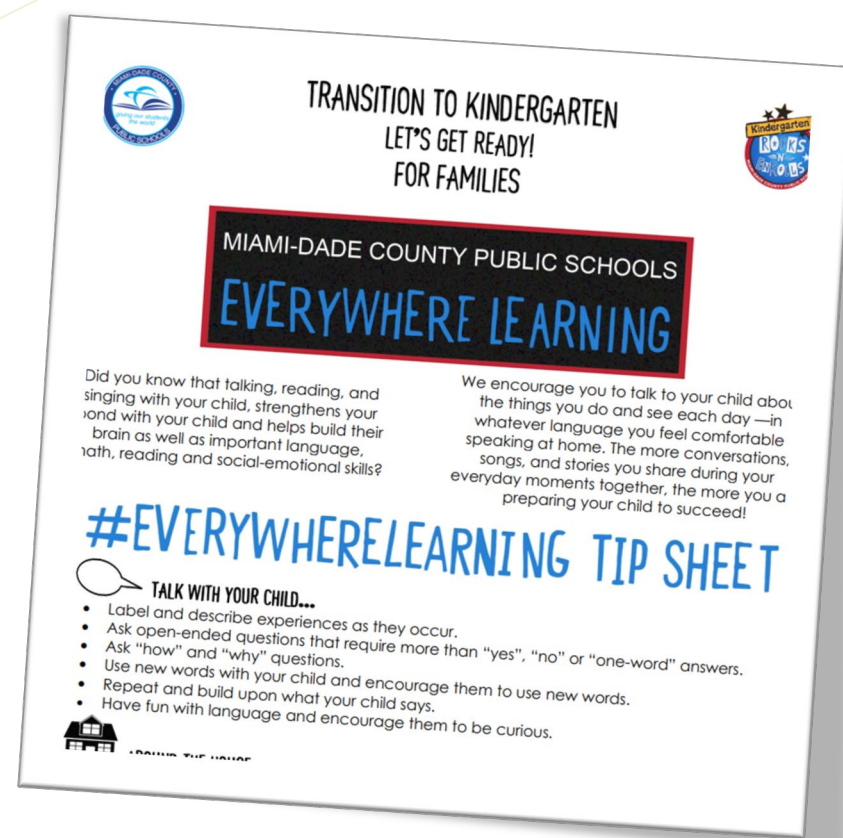



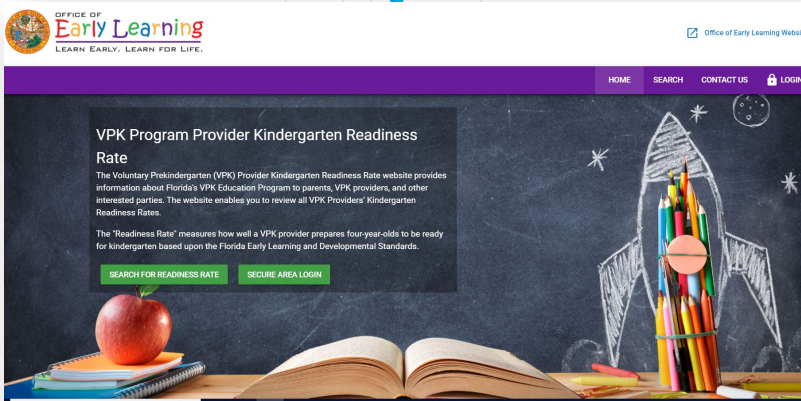
Readiness Rates

- **Preliminary 2020-21 VPK Provider Kindergarten Readiness Rates** have been posted to the VPK Readiness Rate website.
- Provider Verification and Dispute Process will be open until **June 24, 2022**
 - Child Verification
 - Hours Attended
 - File a dispute

Final readiness rates expected to be released the last week of June 2022

The 2020-21 VPK Provider Kindergarten Readiness Rates will only have the effect of removing a VPK provider that is already on probation from that status.

There will be NO NEW VPK providers placed on probation as a result of the final 2020-21 rates.

VPK Assessments

Florida Statute 1002.67(3)

Administration (Conducting the child assessment)

- AP1 - first thirty (30) calendar days of the VPK class schedule
- AP2* - mid-program year
- AP3 - last thirty (30) calendar days of the VPK class schedule ending

Data Submission (Entering children's scores into Bright Beginnings)

- AP1 - within forty-five (45) calendar days of the first day of the VPK class schedule
- AP2* - mid-program year
- AP3 - no later than fifteen (15) calendar days after the last day of the VPK class schedule

***Providers on Probation** who have chosen the Department of Education approved Staff Development Plan are also required to administer and submit data for Assessment Period 2. Providers who are not on probation are not required to administer Assessment Period 2 (AP2); however, strongly recommended.

VPK Assessment and Readiness Rates

Beginning the 2022-2023 school year, a VPK Provider's Readiness Rate, now named **Performance Metric**, will be calculated using the Program Assessment Composite scores (CLASS) and child learning gains on the Progress Monitoring (**Florida's Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) using Star Early Literacy**).

- **FAST** will replace the current VPK Assessment.
- The Assessment will be administered the beginning, middle, and end of the year to track child progress
- It is a computer, adaptive, norm-reference assessment.



Florida's Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) Training

All assessors will be required to complete training before administering the FAST-using Star Early Literacy.
