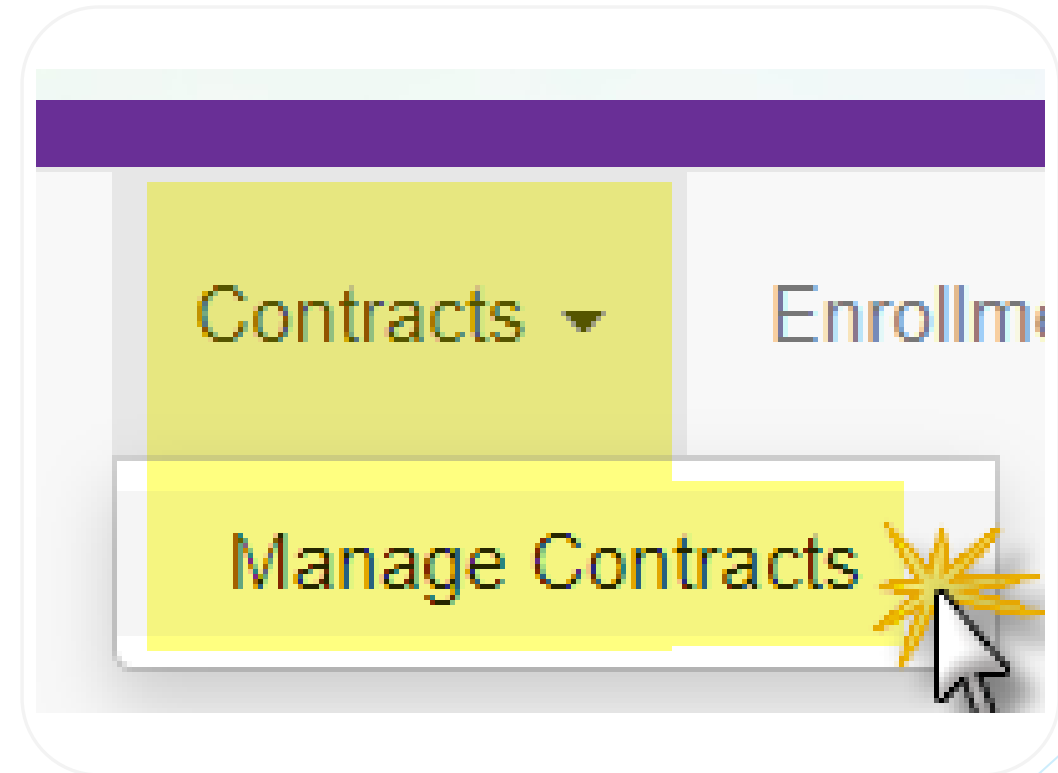

WHAT IS CVI?

- Cortical Visual Impairment (CVI) is the number one cause of pediatric visual impairment in developed and developing countries
- CVI is a brain-based visual impairment
- Unlike ocular vision impairment, functional vision in children with CVI is expected to improve with early diagnosis, appropriate assessment and intervention
- It's not “what the eyes see” it's “how the brain visually interprets what the eyes see”



COMMON CAUSES OF CVI

NATIONAL EYE INSTITUTE

- Lack of oxygen or blood supply to the brain — often because of a stroke
- Hydrocephalus (when fluid builds up in the brain)
- Infections that reach the brain
- Head injury
- Certain genetic conditions



WHAT STUDENTS WITH CVI NEED

- Early, targeted intervention informed and guided by CVI-specific functional vision assessment (The CVI Range)
 - At our CVI Collaborative Center, interventions are designed based on 10 specific visual characteristics and behaviors
- CVI-specific accommodations and modifications are made to learning materials/learning environment to allow visual access
- Ongoing progress tracking and monitoring, as needed



WHAT STUDENTS WITH CVI NEED (cont'd)

- **Examples of CVI-specific Accommodations:**
 - Reduced visual clutter of learning materials and space
 - Use of color/highlighting to elicit visual attention
 - Preferential seating in classroom, away from visual distractions
 - Use of backlighting via lightbox or tablet device for presenting materials
 - Modified worksheets and textbook pages (on digital format) to allow for reduced visual complexity of the array
 - Raising materials up to eye level with slant board
 - Reducing visual clutter of learning environment with focus board
 - Providing visual breaks to avoid visual fatigue



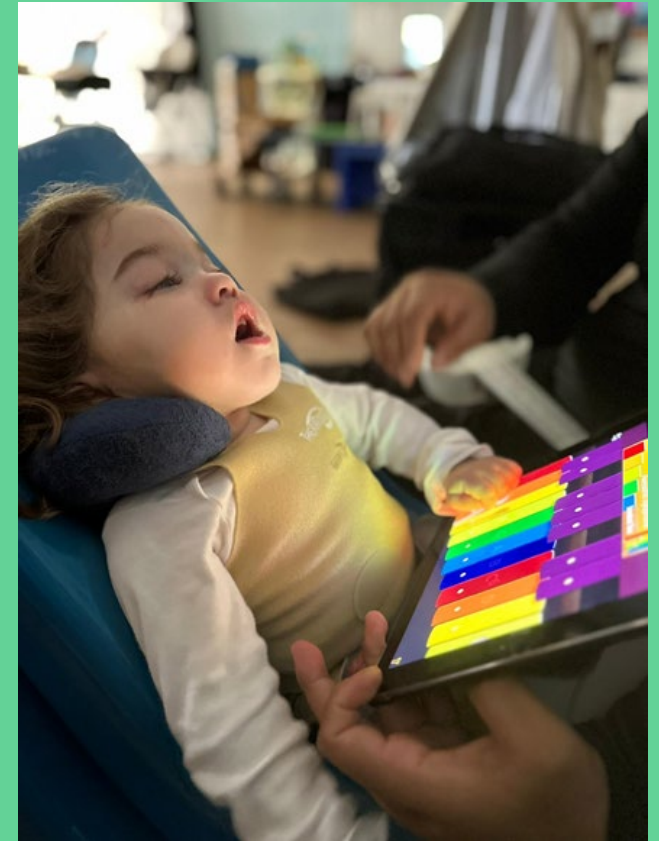
THE MIAMI LIGHTHOUSE CVI COLLABORATIVE CENTER APPROACH

- Inter-professional collaboration is key to addressing CVI in a holistic way: bridging medical diagnosis, functional vision assessment and educational intervention
- We are a team of educators, medical professionals, researchers, service providers, parents
- Our team includes:
 - Pediatric Ophthalmologists at Bascom Palmer Eye Institute
 - Low Vision Optometrists from NOVA Southeastern University College of Optometry: Acquired Brain Injury Clinic
 - Neurologists and Pediatricians from The Brain Institute at Nicklaus Children's Hospital
 - Research Scientist and Administrator in Complex Health Systems, NOVA Southeastern University



ADDRESSING THE UNIQUE NEEDS OF CHILDREN WITH CVI

- Initial CVI Range Assessment and educational planning
- Education-based intervention
- Family support and education
- Onsite and outreach services
- Ongoing professional development & advocacy for professionals working directly with children with CVI



GOAL OF THE PILOT PROJECT

- Extending the resources and services provided in the Miami Lighthouse CVI Collaborative Center to the larger Miami-Dade County area
- Working with collaborative partners and non-profit agencies serving children with visual impairment and other disabilities

 - Easter Seals: Early Steps Southernmost Coast
 - ARC
 - United Way
 - Debbie School
- Developing a holistic national model that can be replicated to address the needs of children with CVI quickly and effectively to promote access to education

? Que es CVI?

- La discapacidad visual cortical (CVI) es la causa número uno de discapacidad visual pediátrica en países desarrollados y en desarrollo
- CVI es una discapacidad visual basada en el cerebro
- A diferencia del deterioro de la visión ocular, se espera que la visión funcional en niños con CVI mejore con un diagnóstico temprano, evaluación e intervención adecuadas
- No es “lo que ven los ojos” es “como el cerebro interpreta visualmente lo que ven los ojos”



Causas comunes de CVI

(Instituto Nacional del Ojo)

- Falta de Oxígeno o suministro de sangre al cerebro, a menudo esto se debe a un accidente cerebrovascular
- Hidrocefalia (cuando se acumula líquido en el cerebro)
- Infecciones cerebrales
- Lesión craneal
- Ciertas condiciones genéticas



Lo que necesitan los estudiantes con CVI

- Intervención temprana-dirigida y guiada por una evaluación funcional de la visión específica de CVI
 - En nuestro Centro Colaborativo estas intervenciones están diseñadas en base a 10 características visuales y comportamientos específicos
- Se realizaran adaptaciones y modificaciones específicas a los materiales de aprendizaje y crear un ambiente de aprendizaje para permitir el acceso visual
- Seguimiento y monitoreo continuo del progreso



Lo que necesitan los estudiantes con CVI (cont.)

- Las siguientes son algunos ejemplos de adaptaciones específicas de CVI:
 - Reducir del desorden visual de materiales de aprendizaje en el espacio
 - Uso de color para llamar la atención visual
 - Colocación de asiento en el salón de clases lejos de distracciones visuales
 - Uso de retroiluminación a través de una caja de luz o una tabla para presentar materiales
 - Páginas de ejercicios o de libros con texto modificados (en formato digital) para permitir o reducir menos complejidad visual
 - Elevar materiales a nivel de los ojos
 - Reducción del desorden visual del entorno de aprendizaje con tablero de enfoque
 - Proporcionar descansos visuales para evitar la fatiga visual



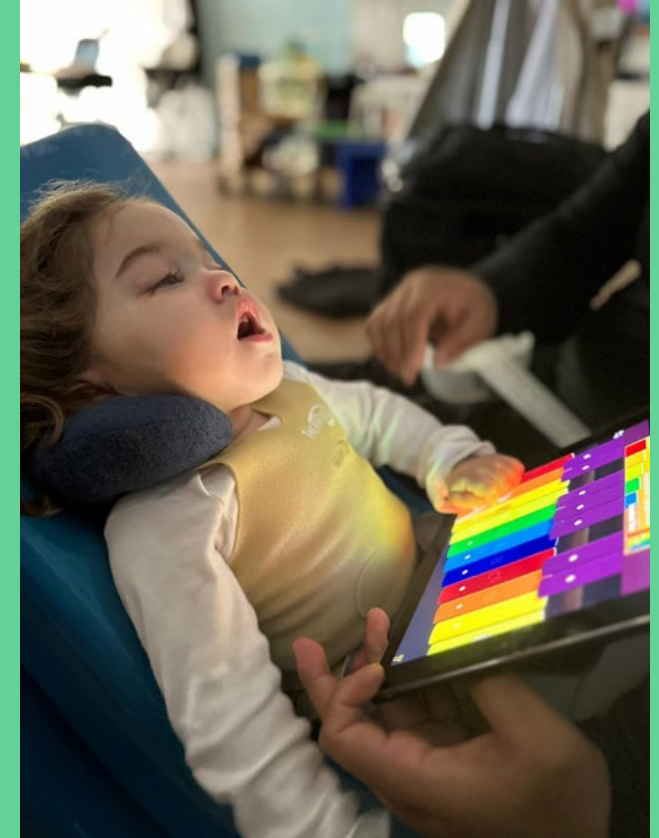
El Enfoque del Centro Colaborativo CVI del Miami Lighthouse

- Nuestro equipo se compone de:
 - Oftalmólogos pediátricos en el Instituto de Bascom Palmer
 - Optometristas de baja visión de NOVA Southeastern University of Optometry: Clínica de Lesiones Cerebrales
 - Neurólogos y Pediatras del Brain Institute del Nicklaus Children's Hospital
 - Investigadores Científicos y administradores en sistemas de salud complejas, NOVA Southeastern University



Como dirigir las necesidades únicas de los niños con CVI

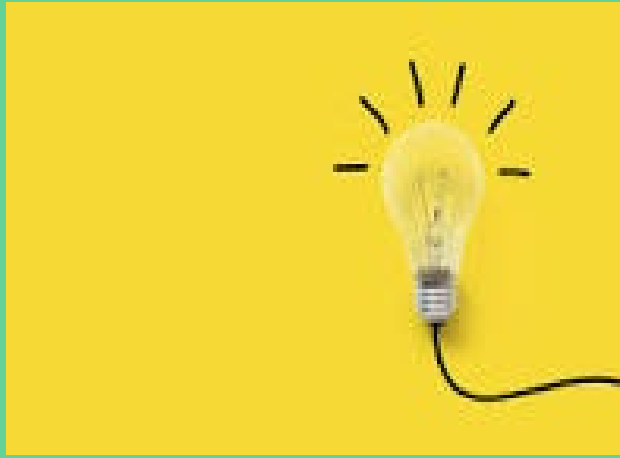
- Evaluación inicial del rango de CVI y planificación educativa

Objetivo del proyecto piloto

- Trabajar colaborativamente con agencias sin fines de lucro que atienden a niños con discapacidad visual y otras discapacidades

 - Easter Seals: Early Steps Southermost Coast
 - ARC
 - United Way
 - Debbie School
- Desarrollar un modelo nacional holístico que se pueda replicar para tratar las necesidades de niños con CVI de una manera rápida y efectiva para promover el acceso a la educación
