All book club members receive a new book every month in English or Spanish along with a guide for parents with activities, information and suggestions about how to share the book with their children.   - If an application is “*rejected*” the application is “incomplete” but family has 30 calendar days to upload requested documents

### *Sample reasons applications are rejected:*

- missing documents (pay stubs)
- there is a lack of information to process application
- family is over income
- family doesn't meet purpose for care

# Progress Monitoring Assessment Deadlines



**Programs that have 83 or more instructional days will follow the below test administration schedule:**

- **Progress Monitoring 1 (PM1)**- First 30 Instructional Days of VPK
- **Progress Monitoring 2 (PM2)**- Mid Program Year (Between 40%-60%) of the program hours)
- **Progress Monitoring 3 (PM3)**- Last 30 Instructional Days of VPK

*All VPK Children must be entered into the EFS Mod Roster as soon as possible. Child Data will be transferred from EFS Mod to the Renaissance System.*

# Program Details

Kindergarten students attending eligible M-DCPS schools can activate their Future Bound Miami account. Over the next five years, our goal is to make this program available to all kindergarten students attending public schools within M-DCPS.



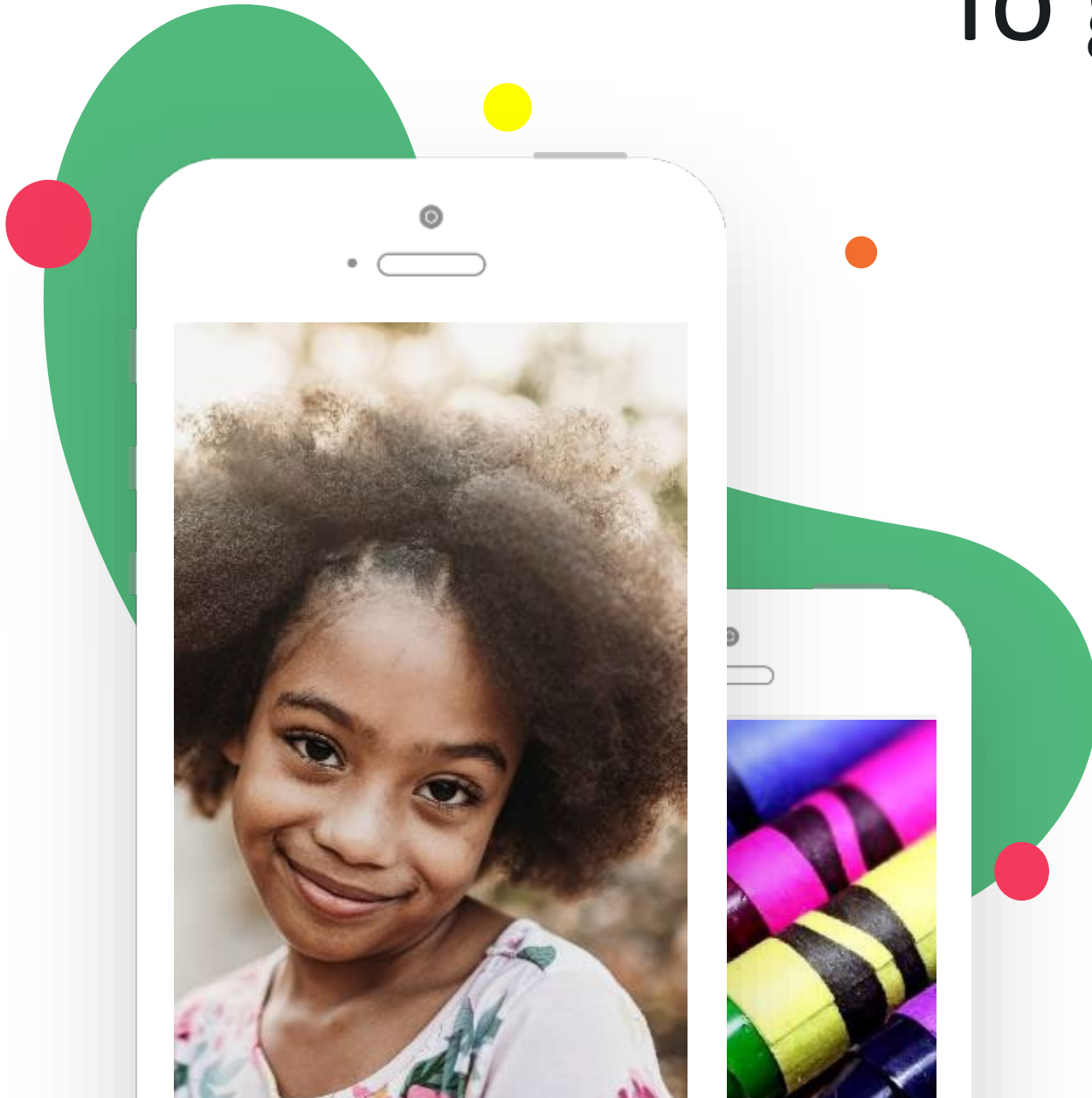
# Research & Impact

Children with \$1 to \$499 saved for school are 3x more likely to enroll in, and 4x more likely to graduate from post-secondary education than children with no account.



# To get you started...

- An initial "seed" incentive of \$25 is added into each student's account at the time of activation.
- An additional \$25 is added into the accounts of students who qualify for Free & Reduced Lunch.



# Account Activation

Future Bound Miami Accounts are managed through the **M-DCPS Student Portal**

# Account Activation

- Deposits are made directly into a student's savings account, which is held at the Educational Federal Credit Union (EdFed).
- **Only the student** may access the account funds upon graduation from an M-DCPS high school.

# Future Bound Miami Account Activation Step 1

The front page of the **Account Activation Form** explains basic information of the Future Bound Miami program and **must** be completed to activate the account.



## Account Activation and Release of Records Form

### Part 1 – Account Activation

Future Bound Miami is a Children's Savings Account (CSA) program providing Kindergarten students at participating Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) elementary schools with a free, long-term, deposit-only savings account for their child's college or postsecondary education housed at the Educational Federal Credit Union (EFCU). When you activate your child's account in Kindergarten, the account will receive an initial deposit of up to \$50 automatically. There is no cost for parents or students to activate the account. You can contribute savings into your student's account at your own pace. From time to time, there will be opportunities to earn additional program contributions dollars dependent on available funding.

Only the student may access the account funds upon graduating from an M-DCPS high school, marking the successful completion of the program. At that time, students will also receive their earned program contributions. If a student leaves M-DCPS prior to completing the program, all non-program contribution dollars deposited during their school career will be returned to the student. However, all program contributions earned through participation in the program will be returned to Future Bound Miami.

After submitting this form to your student's teacher or schools' Future Bound Miami Champion, you will receive a notification via text message and/or email that your student's account has been activated (please allow 2 weeks for account activation). Once you receive this message, you will be able to view your child's account balance in the Future Bound Miami Savings Tracker on the M-DCPS Student Portal. 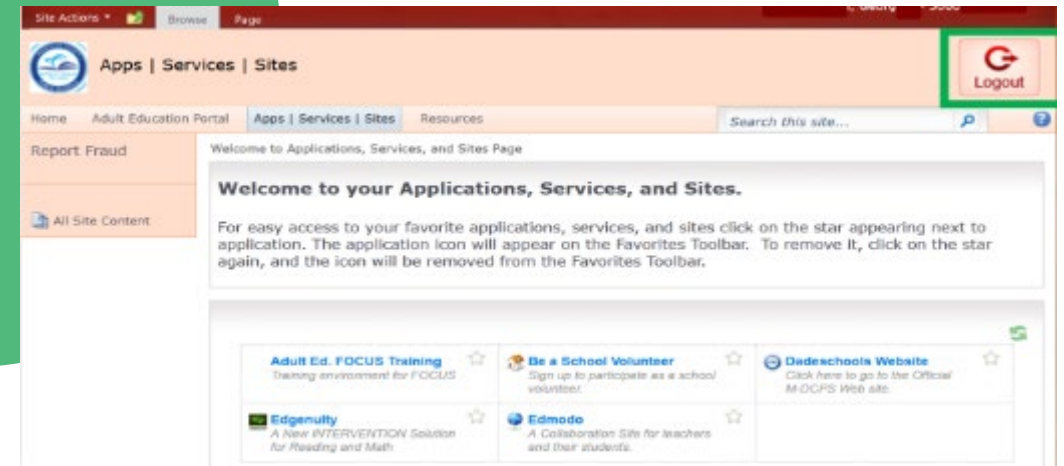

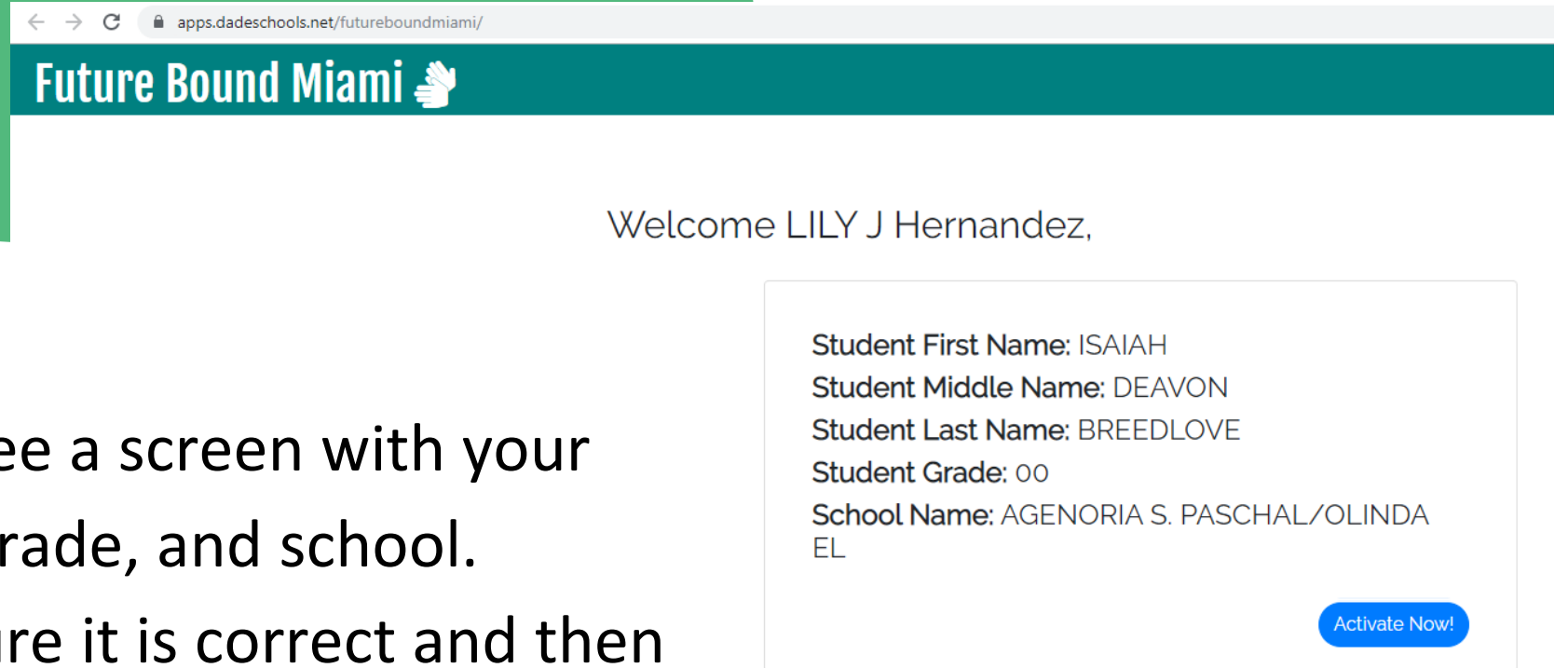
When you log into the Student Portal, click on the Apps|Services|Sites tab on the top left of the screen.

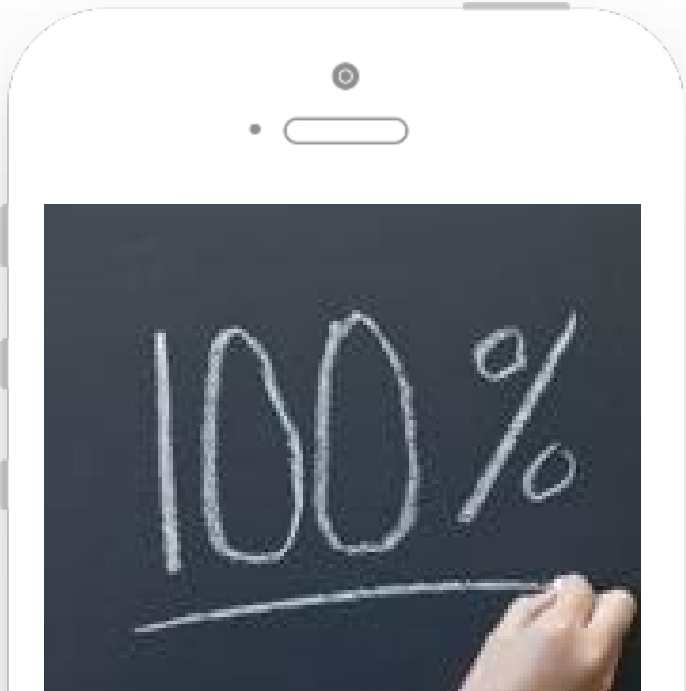

- The initial deposit or "seed money" is graciously donated by Miami-Dade County. Thank you!

- Now that the Future Bound Miami Account is set up and you have waited at least 48 hours since receiving your Account Activation Alert, you can make your first deposit into the account at any EdFed branch.

When you activate your child's account in Kindergarten, the account will receive an initial deposit of up to \$50 automatically. There is no cost for parents or students to activate the account. You can contribute savings into your student's account at your own pace. From time to time, there will be opportunities to earn additional program contributions dollars dependent on available funding.

Only the student may access the account funds upon graduating from an M-DCPS high school, marking the successful completion of the program. At that time, students will also receive their earned program contributions. If a student leaves M-DCPS prior to completing the program, all non-program contribution dollars deposited during their school career will be returned to the student. However, all program contributions earned through participation in the program will be returned to Future Bound Miami.

After submitting this form to your student's teacher or schools' Future Bound Miami Champion, you will receive a notification via text message and/or email that your student's account has been activated (please allow 2 weeks for account activation). 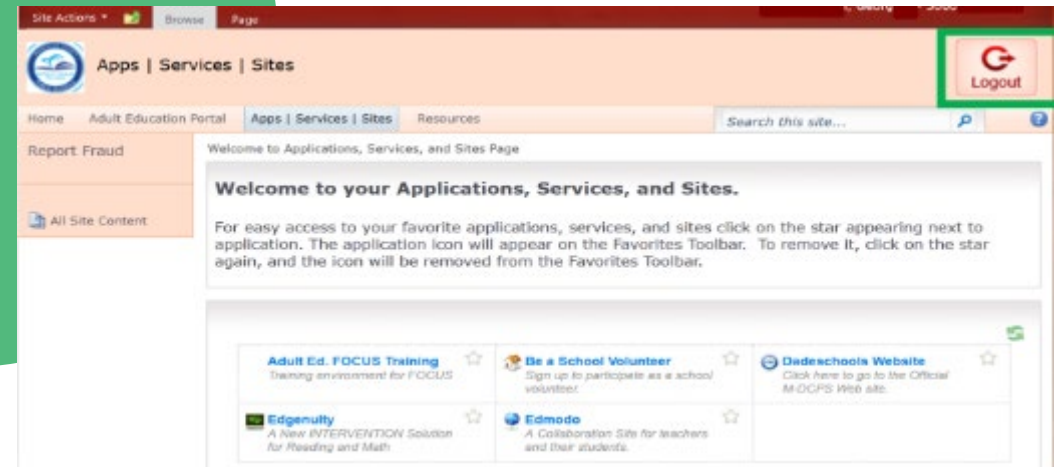

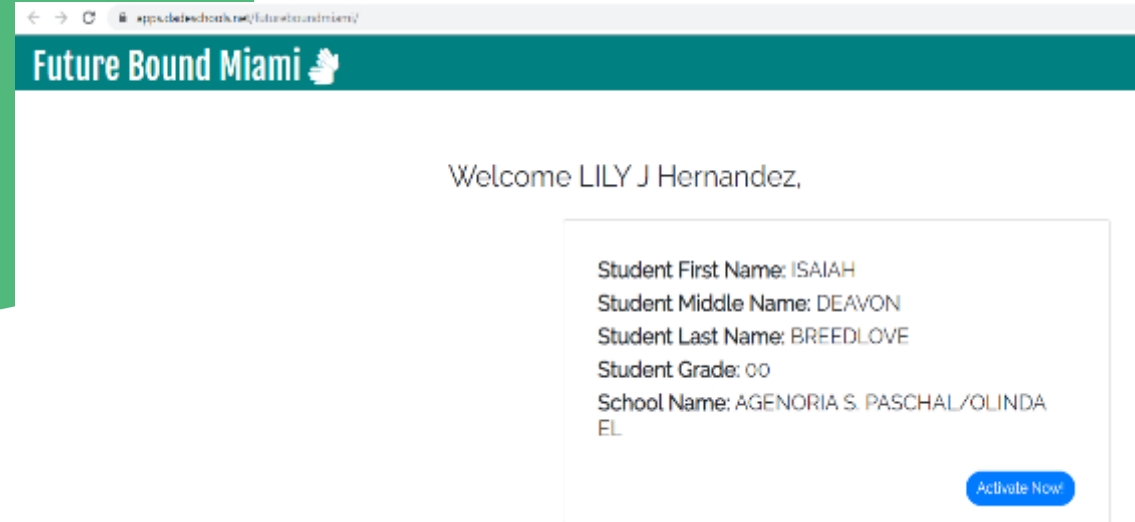

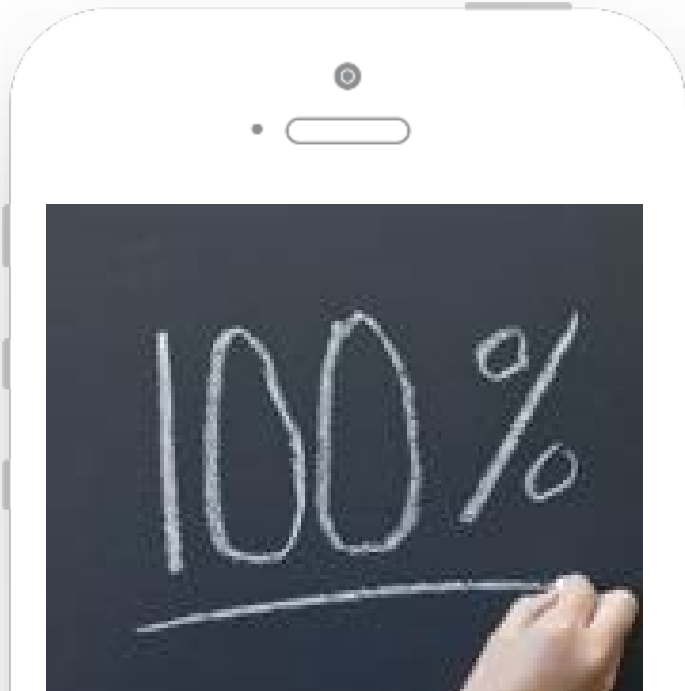
