### Request for Proposal RFP# ELCMDM2019-03 for CLASS Assessment Services

- 1. The RFP states that there is \$175,000 of available funding for CLASS Services and also within that there is up to \$350 for each assessment. Are the expenditures tied to this funding anticipated to be distributed on a per assessment basis or other items as well? If other, what are those items and the estimated cost?**

All costs related to assessments are included in the cost per assessment (e.g., travel, materials {e.g., assessment booklets}, technology, data entry, and achieving and maintaining minimum reliability standards). An entity can be awarded up to \$175,00 taking into consideration that the up to \$350 per assessment includes all assessment related costs.

- 2. The RFP states that there are approximately 3,000 classrooms to assess. How many classroom assessments are estimated to be assessed by awarded contractor / contractors that will be funded by this RFP? This information will assist in our planning for the number of CLASS certified observers.**

An estimated amount of 700 assessments.

- 3. The RFP requires that the proposer should include relevant work history in South Florida with non-profit organizations. Will consideration of relevant work history with other non-profit organizations, including at the state level, be considered?**

Yes, consideration will be given.

- 4. Is there a preferred format / agenda for the January 13th presentations that we should plan for to ensure that the needs of the evaluation committee are delivered verbally? Will the evaluation committee be provided an opportunity to ask questions during the presentation?**
